A Brain SPECT scan (Single-Photon Emission Computed Tomography) is a specialized imaging test that shows how different areas of the brain are functioning. Unlike standard imaging, SPECT highlights brain activity—revealing areas that are healthy, underactive, or overactive.

#### Why It Matters
